Expectations:

We are in important ministry of Christ Church. In order to respect others, honor God and be conscious of our vision, here are the expectations of our members:

- Scheduling - Members will use the worshipplanning.com site to block dates that they are unavailable and promptly respond to invitations to serve (either accept, decline, or tentatively accept)
- Heart - Members will strive for a heart of service, to God and to our congregation. This leads to a positive, encouraging, and collaborative atmosphere within the band. Members will strive for excellence and their personal best in order to honor God and draw people to Him. Nothing we do (whether mistakes or showy performance) should take the focus off of God and onto ourselves.
- Practice/Preparation - Members should do their best to be as prepared as possible in time for rehearsal; this honors everyone else's time, and will lead to smooth rehearsals, creativity, and a higher level of excellence on Sunday.
- Punctuality - Members will commit to being ready to start rehearsal (not just arrive) on time, and arrive early enough to get set up on Sunday as soon as possible. Again, this honors everyone else's time and will give us the greatest chance to achieve excellence in the limited time we have together.
- Personal Spiritual Growth - Each member will commit to growing closer in his or her relationship to God. Drawing others closer to God starts with developing a close personal relationship to God. Everyone is encouraged to take turns leading prayer before rehearsals and services, as well as to develop personal habits of reading the Bible, getting involved in a small group, and personal prayer time. When members are not scheduled to serve, they should still attend worship.
